### HAMPSHIRE AMATEUR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION (NH ASA) CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT BID PROCEDURES

- 1) The actual bid must be submitted on the official NH ASA bid form.
- 2) The bids will be awarded at the annual December meeting, by a majority vote of the State Commissioners Council.
  - a) If at any time during the voting, there are more than three bidders for a tournament and no one receives a majority vote, then the bidder with the least amount of votes will be eliminated from the next round of voting.
- 3) A check (made out to "NHASA") must be included with any bid to host a National Qualifier.

NOTE: 1. The amount of the check to host a tournament is as follows:

  - a. National Qualifier - \$200.00
  2. For National Qualifiers the host league must also submit a fee of \$15.00 per competing team to the National ASA, upon completion of the tournament.
- 4) Each bidder will be advised of the time and place when they may discuss their bid with the Commissioners Council (if necessary).
- 5) If there is only one bid for any particular tournament, the Commissioners Council will make a recommendation to the State Commissioner based on the available data.
- 6) Tournament bids may be awarded two years in advance when the Commissioners Council determines that satisfactory conditions are guaranteed.
- 7) In the event that no satisfactory bid is received for a state, regional, or national qualifier, the State Commissioner shall notify all Council members at the December meeting that bids will be accepted until the February meeting and a vote will be taken at that time.
- 8) The tournament site must provide the following, at no cost to the NH ASA:
  - a) Good playing facilities.
  - b) An official scorer at each field for each game.
  - c) A scoreboard at the main field.
  - d) Rest room facilities.
  - e) Available field lights.
  - f) Water for umpires.
  - g) Field crew to keep site in good playing condition.
  - h) Police, if necessary.
  - i) A site contact person to work with the tournament director and umpire in chief (UIC).
  - j) Umpires, game balls, and trophies (For National Qualifiers only) (NH ASA will provide Tournament Director/UIC).
- 9) The NH ASA will provide the following for state and regional tournaments:
  - a) Tournament Director and UIC.
  - b) Umpires.
  - c) Game balls.
  - d) All trophies.
  - e) Scorebooks and line-up cards.
  - f) A bracket board at the main field.
  - g) \$10.00 per participating team (For adult slow pitch state tournaments only, provided they receive an 80% rating or higher).
